WHAT, HOW ?

The *Etat de Genève* is creating a new public space around the CERN tram stop, between the CERN Reception and the Globe of Science and Innovation. This space is one of the components of the franco-valdo-genevoise urban development project and will constitute a gateway to International Geneva. It is intended to symbolise the progress being made towards mixed-mode travel.

Work will begin on **Tuesday, 18 April 2017** and will continue until the end of July 2018. It will involve the diversion of traffic on the Route de Meyrin but **the road will not be closed**.

Public transport (bus Y and tram 18) on the Route de Meyrin will **continue to operate** during the work.

The CERN entrances and the SOCAR petrol station will remain accessible throughout the work.

Although every effort will be made to limit the impact of the work, you may experience some inconvenience. The contracting authority would like to thank residents in advance for their understanding regarding any inconvenience caused.

WHEN, HOW LONG ?

From 18 April 2017 until the end of July 2018. In the event of adverse weather conditions, the work may take longer to complete.

The civil-engineering directorate recommends that road users exercise caution during the work and comply with all temporary traffic signs. Everything possible will be done to reduce the inconvenience caused by the work.

WHY ?

CERN has buildings on both sides of the public space and, as one of the most popular international institutions in the region, welcomes more than 120 000 visitors annually. This project will mark the entry into International Geneva on the Route de Meyrin, establish continuity between CERN's Globe and its exhibitions for the general public, create a one-of-a-kind contemporary public space and improve sustainable transport links.

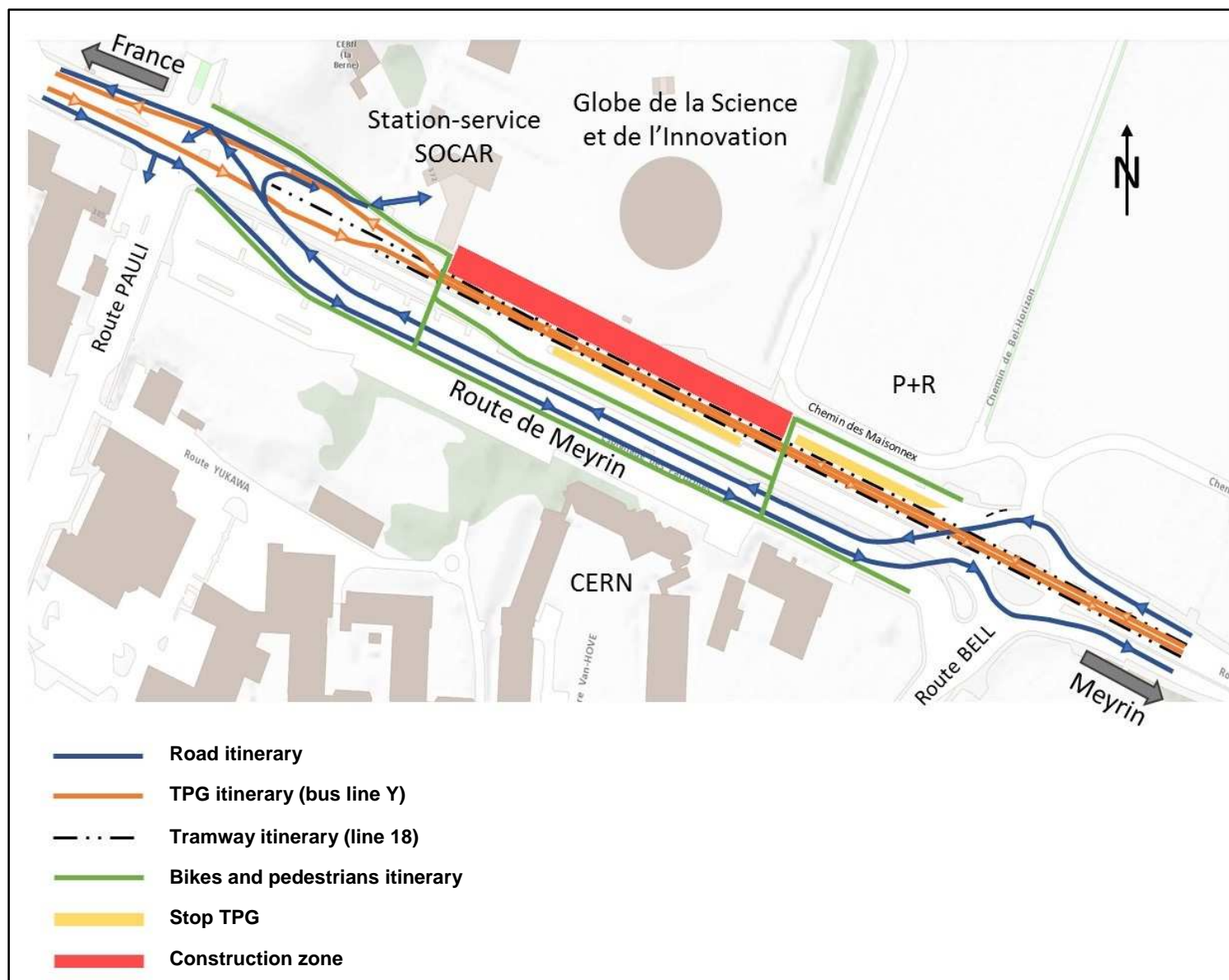
